1. Trend, Seasonality, and Noise.

2. Trend — the long-term direction of the data: increasing or decreasing.

3. Seasonality — a regular pattern that repeats at a fixed interval.

4. Noise — an unusual point that doesn't fit the trend or the seasonal pattern.

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5. Trend — an increasing long-term trend from 2015 to 2020.

6. Seasonality — a pattern that repeats every summer, year after year.

7. Noise — a one-off, unusual event (the burst pipe) that doesn't fit the regular pattern.

8. False. Trend should be described as increasing or decreasing — “positive”/“negative” describe number signs, not direction.
