

Start Tasks — Answers



1. Convert 3 L to mL.

Solution

$$3 \times 1000 = 3000 \text{ mL}$$

2. Convert 2000 mL to L.

Solution

$$2000 \div 1000 = 2 \text{ L}$$

3. Convert 2.5 L to mL.

Solution

$$2.5 \times 1000 = 2500 \text{ mL}$$

4. Convert 750 mL to L.

Solution

$$750 \div 1000 = 0.75 \text{ L}$$

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5. Which is more: 3 L or 2900 mL?

Solution

$$3 \text{ L} = 3000 \text{ mL}$$

$3000 > 2900$, so 3 L is more

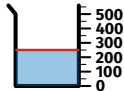
6. Which is less: 1500 mL or 1.2 L?

Solution

$$1.2 \text{ L} = 1200 \text{ mL}$$

$1200 < 1500$, so 1.2 L is less

7. What is the reading, in mL?



Solution

Reading is 250 mL

8. Convert 1.75 L to mL.

Solution

$$1.75 \times 1000 = 1750 \text{ mL}$$

9. Convert 420 mL to L (2 d.p.).

Solution

$$420 \div 1000 = 0.42 \text{ L}$$

10. A bottle holds 2.3 L. Convert this to mL.

Solution

$$2.3 \times 1000 = 2300 \text{ mL}$$

11. Convert 4 L to mL.

Solution

$$4 \times 1000 = 4000 \text{ mL}$$

12. Convert 850 mL to L.

Solution

$$850 \div 1000 = 0.85 \text{ L}$$
