

Start Tasks Answers



1. Centre, Shape, Spread, Interesting (features).

2. Centre — the middle of the data: median or mean.

3. Shape — left skew, right skew, or symmetric (bell curve).

4. Spread — the interquartile range (IQR) or the range.

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5. The median (the middle value of the data).

6. $IQR = Q3 - Q1$ — the range of the middle 50% of the data.

7. Interesting features — e.g. outliers or groups in the data.

8. Range = maximum — minimum — shown by the full span of the whiskers.
